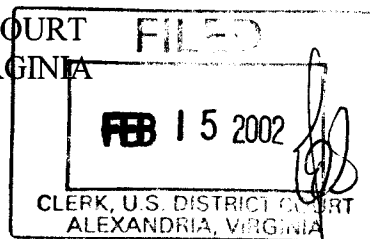

The deposition may be taken by ordinary stenographic means and/or by videotape.

The Special Administrative Measures (SAMs) in effect for the defendant, and any which may apply to the witness, shall remain in effect throughout the deposition. The defendant shall be shackled at all times.

Prior to the deposition, the government is directed to produce any items or materials seized or obtained from Mr. Oulai at the time of his arrest and any other materials which would assist in the taking of a meaningful deposition.




