ORDER

On July 8, 2002, the defendant, <u>pro se</u>, filed six motions and one reply, which were initially filed under seal to enable the United States to review them before they are placed in the open case file. Having been advised by the United States that it does not object to these pleadings being in the open case file, it is hereby

ORDERED that pleadings docketed as #s 280, 281, 286, 287, 288 and 289 be and are unsealed.

In our Order dated July 8, 2002, we directed the Clerk to file ex parte and under seal defendant's pro se Motion to be Handed All Print Out of [sic] Death Appointed Lawyer McMahon [sic] and Federal Public Defender of Defense Production and Material Before June 13, 2002 (Docket #282). We also instructed the defendant to advise the Court in writing if he wished to have a copy of that pleading turned over to the United States and/or placed in the public case file. The defendant, pro se, has since filed a Motion to Have Right to Public Trial (Docket # 296) in

which he informs the Court of his desire to have this motion publicly filed. Therefore, Defendant's Motion to Have Right to Public Trial is GRANTED; and it is hereby

ORDERED that a copy the defendant's <u>pro se</u> Motion to be Handed All Print Out of [sic] Death Appointed Lawyer McMahon [sic] and Federal Public Defender of Defense Production and Material Before June 13, 2002 (Docket #282) be provided to counsel for the United States. If the United States does not object to this pleading being unsealed, it will be unsealed and placed in the public file with all other unsealed pleadings.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, <u>pro se;</u> counsel for the United States; standby defense counsel; and the Court Security Officer.
