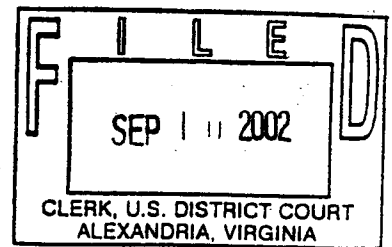

UNDER SEAL

ORDER

By a letter dated September 10, 2002, the United States has renewed its request for permission to replace the paper copies of the FBI 302s previously provided to the defendant and since removed from his discovery room.¹ The replacement production would not include the documents identified as having been inadvertently produced to the defendant.

This substitute production is necessary because the lack of clear organization and indexing of the boxes of discovery material has made it impossible for the Court Security Officers to locate all of the documents they were directed to recover by our Order of September 6, 2002. Therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the United States reprint an entire set of the FBI 302s to which the defendant is entitled to have access, without the documents identified as having been inadvertently produced to him, by the close of business on Tuesday, September

17, 2002; and it is further

ORDERED that the United States organize and index the documents in a clear and intelligible manner; and it is further

ORDERED that the Court Security Officers maintain all seized boxes of discovery under seal as part of the permanent record of this case.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to the defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; standby defense counsel; the Court Security Officer; and the United States Marshal.
