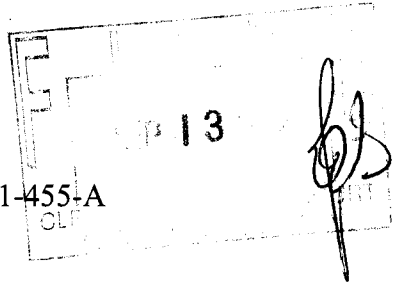

GOVERNMENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE REPLY TO
THE RESPONSE OF STANDBY COUNSEL TO GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO USE
SUMMARY WITNESS REGARDING WORLD TRADE CENTER ATTACKS

On September 6, 2002, standby counsel filed its response to the Government's Motion to Use Summary Witness Regarding World Trade Center Attacks. This response was filed well in advance of the newly established motions schedule apparently because the Government filed its motion well in advance of the new schedule. Because the Government is unsure whether the new motions schedule applies to this motion or that the Government has three days to reply to the standby counsel's response as provided in the Local Rules, the Government respectfully requests the Court to allow it to file its reply not later than September 23, 2002.¹ Mr. Dunham has no objection to this request.


¹One reason for this requested delay is that AUSA Novak, who is handling this motion, has had a death occur in his family, thereby reducing the time that he can work on the reply.
