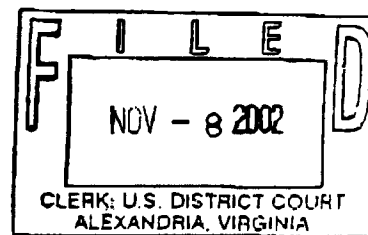

ORDER

The defendant, pro se, has filed a Motion to Get the [REDACTED]
