ORDER

For the reasons stated during a closed hearing held on February 5, 2003, the defendant's pro se Motion to Get Inform [sic] About the Decision Relating to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is GRANTED. However, because our Order of January 31, 2003 has been classified as "Secret," and the Alexandria City Adult Detention Center does not have appropriately secure facilities in which to maintain the Order, it is hereby

ORDERED that Mr. Moussaoui's copy of the redacted and edited version of our Order be retained by standby counsel, who will make it available for the defendant's review upon request.

The United States has indicated that it may appeal our ruling, and has requested that we suspend requiring the parties to submit a proposed CIPA schedule until that determination has been made. Finding this request to be reasonable, it is hereby

ORDERED that the portion of our Order of January 31, 2003 directing the United States and standby counsel to submit a

proposed CIPA schedule by Wednesday, February 5, 2003 is VACATED.
