GOVERNMENT'S OPPOSITION TO STANDBY COUNSEL'S
MOTION TO HAVE IBRAHIM ANDERSON ATTEND THE NDIAYE DEPOSITION

The United States opposes standby counsel's request to have Ibrahim Anderson attend the deposition of Iman Ndiaye.

Although Mr. Anderson may ease Imam Ndiaye's anxiety about traveling to Alexandria and attending a court proceeding, the deposition will be conducted under seal and Mr. Anderson has no role in the proceeding. Nor has standby counsel provided any authority or principled reason supporting Mr. Anderson's attendance at a sealed proceeding. Mr. Anderson's willingness to travel from Oklahoma to Alexandria and his presence outside the courtroom should provide sufficient ease to Imam Ndiaye.
