SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE OF THE UNITED STATES TO INTERVENORS'
MOTION FOR ACCESS TO CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE RECORD

The United States respectfully submits this supplemental response to the media intervenors' motion for access to certain portions of the record.

In its original response to the motion for access, the United States identified the pleading assigned docket number 701 as a classified document. Since filing that response, the government has obtained from the court's security officer a redacted, unclassified version of that pleading. The United States does not object to the release of the redacted, unclassified version of the pleading assigned docket number 701. For the reasons stated in the original response, however, the underlying classified document should remain sealed.

The United States also indicated in its original response that it would submit proposed redacted and unclassified copies of Nos. 585, 688, 715, and 724 to the Court so that it may consider releasing those redacted and unclassified copies. The redacted, unclassified copies of Nos. 585, 701, 715, and 724 are attached hereto as under seal exhibits 1 through 4. The government respectfully

requests additional time (until this Friday, May 9) to determine whether unclassified portions of No. 688 should nonetheless remain sealed because they refer to and set out details of other documents that presently are under seal and to provide the court with an alternative proposed redacted version of No. 688.
