ORDER

In his pro se Motion docketed as #906, the defendant complains that the Court's Order of May 7, 2003 directing him to turn over to standby counsel any and all notes taken concerning the Government's Proposed Substitutions makes it impossible for him to prepare his brief to the Court of Appeals. The Court's Order of May 7, 2003 does not prevent the defendant from incorporating information, including quotations, from the Proposed Substitutions in any pleadings to be filed in this Court or the Court of Appeals. Rather, because the defendant is not permitted to retain classified information in his cell, that Order merely requires the defendant to give to his standby counsel for proper storage any notes or drafts containing classified information. When the defendant needs these materials, his standby counsel will bring them to the jail for his use. Because this Motion does not ask for specific judicial relief, it is DENIED.

defendant, pro se; counsel for the United States; and standby
defense counsel.
