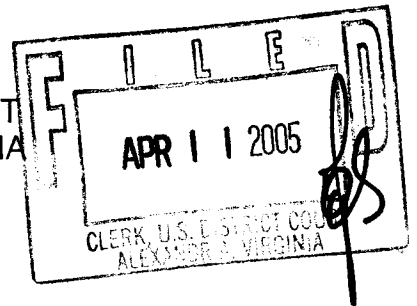

ORDER

Before the Court is Defendant's Motion to Temporarily Unseal Materials filed on April 11, 2005. That motion requests that the Court temporarily unseal materials sealed by Court Orders dated October 7, 2002 and July 22, 2004 (docket nos. 598 and 1183, respectively) (the "Sealing Orders"). For good cause shown, it is hereby

ORDERED that said motion is Granted; and

FURTHER ORDERED that the materials subject to the Sealing Orders be temporarily unsealed to permit defense counsel, their mitigation specialist, and their outside mental health experts to view them in the Clerk's Office or in the Office of the United States Marshal if the Clerk's Office does not have the necessary equipment to allow for viewing; and

FURTHER ORDERED that the materials subject to the Sealing Orders be re-sealed under the same terms and conditions of those orders once defense counsel, their mitigation specialist, and their outside mental health experts have viewed the materials; and

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court furnish a copy of this Order forthwith to counsel for the defendant and the government.
