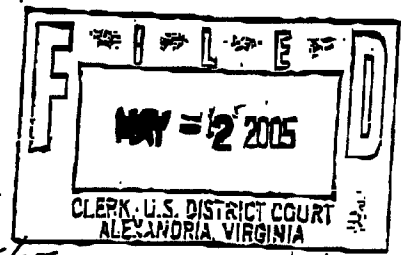

ORDER

For the reasons stated on the record in a sealed hearing on April 28, 2005, defendant's Motion For Reevaluation Of Orders Issued Pursuant To Section 4 Of The Classified Information Procedures Act And To Establish Procedures For Implementing The Mandate Of The Court Of Appeals is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART.

With regard to defendant's requests for reevaluation of previously filed Section 4 Orders and disclosure of the

witnesses at issue [REDACTED] they made the statements incorporated into the [REDACTED] reports and summaries submitted to the Court, it is hereby

ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of this Order, the Government must submit to the Court written representations, subject to the penalty of perjury, from all [REDACTED] involved in

ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of this Order, the Government must submit to the Court detailed documentation. [REDACTED]

ORDERED that within thirty (30) days of this Order, the Government must submit to the Court a list of the titles and filing dates of all motions relating to these [REDACTED] witnesses that were previously filed ex parte pursuant to Section 4 of the Classified Information Procedures Act ("CIPA"), which the Court will then provide to defense counsel; and it is further

ORDERED that in the future, the Government may not file Section 4 motions regarding these [REDACTED] witnesses ex parte except in the case of demonstrated extraordinary circumstances.

The other relief requested by defendant has been adequately addressed on the record.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record and the Court Security Officer.
