DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Defendant Zacarias Moussaoui ("Moussaoui"), through counsel, moves the Court to grant a one week extension of the time within which he must respond to the two classified/under seal Government oppositions (the "Oppositions") that were filed on Friday, June 10, 2005. These Oppositions were filed in response to two classified/under seal motions Moussaoui filed on May 17 and 27, 2005 (dkt. nos. 1283 and 1292, respectively). Moussaoui's response to the Oppositions is due Wednesday, June 15, 2005. See Loc. Crim. R. 47(F)(1).

The Oppositions raise challenges to evidence that Moussaoui believes is critical to the penalty phase of this case. One of the Oppositions also proposes a partial compromise that deserves consideration which the currently short response time does not fully allow. Finally, the Government has informed defense counsel that it does not oppose the instant motion.

For these reasons, Moussaoui respectfully requests that the Court extend until Wednesday, June 22, 2005, the time within which he must respond to the Oppositions. Defendant will endeavor to file his responses before then if it is at all possible to do so. A proposed order is attached for the Court's consideration.
