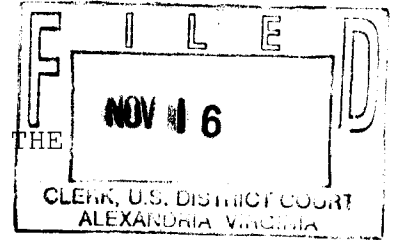

ORDER

The government has asked the Court to resolve its long-pending Motion to Quash Subpoena Duces Tecum Served on the Central Intelligence Agency ("CIA") ("Motion to Quash") (Docket #679). Much has changed in this case since the defense first served the subpoena at issue. Among these changes are the extraordinary amount of discovery produced to the defense and the guilty pleas of the defendant to all counts in the indictment.

For these reasons, the Motion to Quash (Docket #679) is GRANTED without prejudice to the defendant requesting issuance of a new subpoena if defense counsel believe the CIA retains material, non-cumulative evidence to which the defendant is entitled.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record and the Court Security Officer.
