**MOTION OF INTERVENOR AIR LINE PILOTS ASSOCIATION, INT'L FOR  
RECONSIDERATION OF ORDER PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC DISCLOSURE OF  
THE COCKPIT VOICE RECORDER OF UNITED FLIGHT 93**

Intervenor Air Line Pilots Association, Int'l ("ALPA") respectfully requests that the Court reconsider its April 5, 2006 Order providing for public disclosure of the cockpit voice recorder (CVR) of United Flight 93 from September 11, 2001, unless a family member of one of the Flight 93 victims objects. (Docket #1750.) ALPA requests that the Court seal the CVR after it is heard by the jury and instead make available to the public only a transcript of the relevant portions or of the entire tape recording.

The Court should reconsider its April 5, 2006 Order for two reasons. First, a federal statute, 49 U.S.C. § 1154, specifically protects the CVR from public disclosure. Moreover, because of this protection, disclosure of a transcript of the tape recording would comply with the rulings of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit in its recent decision, In re Associated Press, No. 06-1301, 2006 WL 752044 (4<sup>th</sup> Cir. Mar. 22, 2006). These reasons are
