ORDER

With the agreement of counsel for both the government and the defendant, and to facilitate the ability of viewers at the off site locations to be present for the return of the jury's decision and the sentencing of the defendant, it is hereby

ORDERED that the announcement of the jury's decision in open court will be delayed one hour from when the jury notifies the Court that it has reached a decision, and it is further

ORDERED that as the decision is announced in the courtroom, it will be simultaneously read by the Court's public information officer at the media's pool microphone stand on Courthouse Square, as it was in the first phase of this proceeding, and it is further

ORDERED that during the announcement of the jury's decision, all spectators in Courtrooms 700, 701 and 801 will be required to remain in the courtrooms until the conclusion of the proceeding, and it is further

ORDERED that if the decision is announced before 12:30 p.m., the defendant will be sentenced at 3:00 p.m. on the day the decision is announced. If the decision is announced after 12:30 p.m., the defendant will be sentenced at 10:00 a.m. on the next business day. If the announcement is on a Friday after 12:30 p.m., the defendant will be sentenced at 10:00 a.m. the following Monday.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record, the United States Probation Office and the United States Marshals Service.
