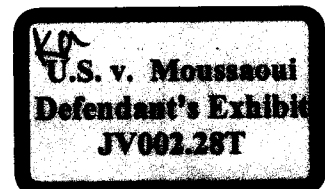

SEISIN AND SUMMONS

Whereas in a ruling against the defaulting plaintiff dated 12 /14 /1984, this Court sentenced MOUSSAOUI to four months imprisonment (suspended), a fine of FF 3,000 and FF 1,000 for the offence of having, on 9 / 19 / 1983, in Sigean, stolen from Messrs. Olivière and Jacques, various tools and equipment: a rubber mortar box, a no. 20 trowel, a tiler's hammer, an aluminum ruler, an upholsterer's brush (Franpin brand), two floats, a pair of pincers (Coupex brand)), a plumb line, a 50 meter marking line, two plastic buckets, two aluminum rulers, a trowel, a green bucket, three small pegs;  
in 1983, in the department of Aude, of having committed the related offence: worked as a masonry contractor for pay, without having



requested to be included in the professional listings or registered with the Trade Register and without having complied with his tax or corporate obligations.

Actions set forth in and punishable pursuant to Articles 379, 381 of the Penal Code, L 324/9 and R 362/3 of the Work Code;

ARGUMENTS AND GROUNDS FOR RULING

The arguments were heard during today's hearing.

The defendant presented his defense.

Whereas Omar Moussaoui had, on June 12, 1985, objected to the above-mentioned ruling and was XXXXXXXX notified of the hearing on this date;

Whereas the objection is admissible in its form;

Whereas in substance, it is based on documents of the case and the arguments that the crimes with which the defendant has been accused are well-founded; that there are, in this case, extenuating circumstances.

ON THESE GROUNDS

THE COURT: ruling in open court after hearing both sides and in first appeal.

The Court admits Omar Moussaoui's legal objection in its form;

Annuls the ruling dated December 14, 1984 and issuing a new ruling;

Declares him guilty of the crimes of which he has been accused;

Sentences him to a term of FOUR months of prison and a fine of FF THREE THOUSAND for the offences and a fine of FF ONE THOUSAND for the noncompliance (upholding the first ruling)

Rule that the prison sentence shall be suspended, pursuant to Article 734 of the Criminal Law Code;

Restitution of the seized equipment to Mr. Jacques.

In addition, sentences him to the repayment of costs, set at FF 522.84, which includes the set proceedings fee of FF 250.00.

Sets the imprisonment for debts at the minimum;

All this pursuant to the above-mentioned laws and Articles 463 of the criminal Code, 473 and 749 of the Criminal Law Code.
