Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to provide some additional information regarding the applicants housing background and present circumstances.

Mr Moussaoui arrived in London from France in February 1992. Initially he slept rough for a few nights until he was introduced to the 'New To London' project. 'New To London' manage very short-term hostel accommodation, and they referred Mr Moussaoui to Nevern Mansions. He joined us on 4th June 1992. Nevern Mansions is a second stage hostel for single homeless people, arranged into cluster flats. All accommodation is self-catered.

As the project is funded under the Single Homeless Initiative, it is due to close in June 1994. Resettlement is therefore a priority and for Mr Moussaoui a matter of some urgency.

Mr Moussaoui occupies a single room in a shared flat. He shares facilities with 10 others, none of whom are of any relation to him. He is able to live independently and during his time with us, he has presented no problems in terms of arrears or with his general demeanour in the hostel. He is claiming Income Support and Housing Benefit.

I hope that you consider his application favourably, and we look forward to your response.
